

1,2,3 Where are you?

Description/Instructions:

1,2,3 Where are you? is an adaption of the popular game of hide and seek.

- One child is chosen to be the seeker.
- All other children are given a set amount of time to hide.
- The seeker then calls out '1,2,3 Where are you?'
- The children hiding all have to reply with '1,2,3 over here'.
- The seeker moves around repeating this call and listening for the replies to help locate all of the hidiers.
- At any point the seeker can call out '1,2,3 come to me' and all hidiers have to reveal themselves and make their way to the seeker.

How could this activity be adapted for different learners?

- Different lengths of time to hide.
- When found a child can join the seeker to look for the others.
- Camouflage or hi-vis jackets could be used to make it easier or more difficult to hide.
- A whistle could be used instead of calling out.

What tools or equipment are needed?

- Camouflage or hi-vis jackets if appropriate.
- Whistles is appropriate.

What themes or topics could this activity support?

Establishing boundaries. Building trust. Senses - listening.

What areas of development could this activity support?
